REPENT

"You are the man." These words, spoken to King David by the prophet Nathan in the passage just before today's first reading, were a wake-up call to David that he had done wrong in taking the wife of Uriah and having Uriah killed in battle.

The story that woke David up to his own guilt was about a rich man who had many sheep, but took and slaughtered the only sheep of a poor man. David thought the man should be punished, but when Nathan made known to him that this story was about David himself, David woke up to his own sin and repented, and the Lord forgave him.

Today's psalm of David reinforces for us the necessity of recognizing our own guilt and confessing it before the Lord. Then "blessed is the one whose fault is taken away, / whose sin is covered" (Psalm 32:1). God becomes our shelter, and gives us back our freedom. © Copyright, J. S. Paluch Co.

"My brothers and sisters, I come to you today clothed in truth and openness. I hide nothing from you. I have no ulterior motive aside from the safety, salvation and well-being of every soul from the moment of conception until natural death. I beg your country today to take heed of My call to end legalized abortion. Do not wait until My solution is your last alternative."

"I desire that all humanity unite under the Seal of Holy and Divine Love--the two great commandments that embrace all the commandments. Sacred Heart Feast Day



At the age of 24, Margaret Mary entered the Visitation convent at Paray-le-Monial in France. She began to have visions of Our Lord. On December 27, 1673, on the Feast of St. John, she began to have visions that lasted for eighteen months. Jesus told her that she was to become his instrument in spreading devotion to his Sacred Heart. While kneeling before the Blessed Sacrament, Our Lord appeared to her and invited her to "rest a long time on His Divine Breast". Jesus revealed to her

the marvels of the love that His Sacred Heart had for mankind.

Jesus said to her: ***"My Divine Heart is so Full of Love for men and for YOU in particular that it is no longer able to contain within Itself the Flames of its Burning Charity. It must spread those flames by means of YOU, and it must manifest itself to men in order to enrich them with its precious treasures! I have chosen You to achieve this Grand Crusade of Love."***

According to Saint Margaret Mary, His Divine Heart was *"more radiant than the sun and as transparent as crystal,"* with its adorable wound visible, and as a *"furnace"* of burning flames.

In June, 1675: during the feast of Corpus Christi, while praying before Our Lord in the Most Blessed Sacrament of the Monstrance. Our Lord revealed His Heart to her and said:

"Here is the Heart that has so loved men as to spare nothing for them, exhausting and consuming itself in order to prove its Love for them; and in return I receive from most of them only ingratitude."

Jesus asked her to have a special feast established in honor of His Sacred Heart on the Friday after the feast of Corpus Christi. Jesus asked his followers to receive Holy Communion on that day and to make atonement for the sins of the world by an act of reparation.

Promises of the Sacred Heart of Jesus to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque

1. "I will give them all the graces necessary in their state of life."
2. "I will establish peace in their homes."
3. "I will comfort them in their afflictions."
4. "I will be their secure refuge during life, and above all in death."
5. "I will bestow a large blessing upon all their undertakings."
6. "Sinners shall find in My Heart the source and the infinite ocean of mercy."
7. "Tepid souls shall grow fervent."
8. "Fervent souls shall quickly mount to high perfection."
9. "I will bless every place where a picture of My Heart shall be set up and honored."
10. "I will give to priests the gift of touching the most hardened hearts."
11. "Those who shall promote this devotion shall have their names written in My Heart, never to be blotted out."
12. "I promise thee in the excessive mercy of My Heart that My all-powerful love will grant to all those who communicate on the First Friday in nine consecutive months, the grace of final penitence; they shall not die in My disgrace nor without receiving the Sacraments; My Divine heart shall be their safe refuge in this last moment."
